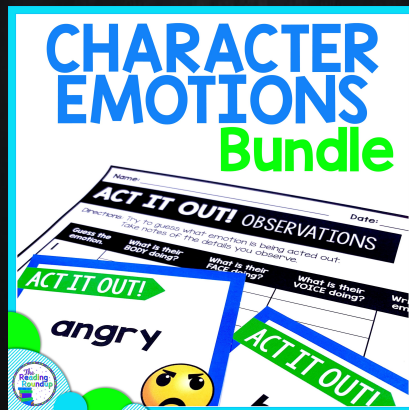

# EMOTIONS CHARTS



These character emotions charts can be used in a variety of ways. Students can use them to:

- express how they're feeling
- add details to their writing
- infer how characters are feeling

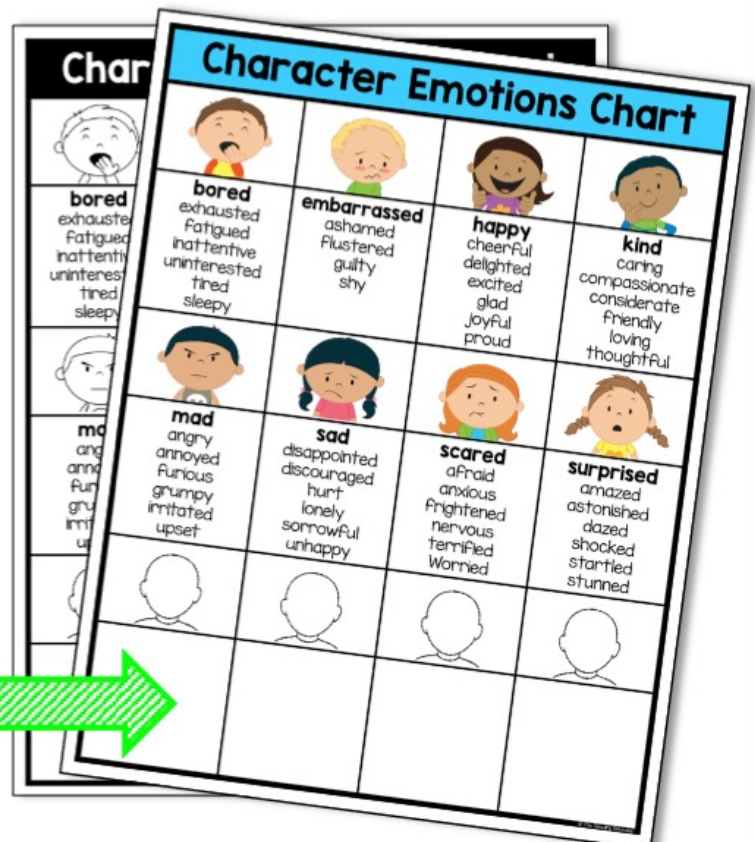
Use them in different places:

- Add them to students' writing folders
- Glue into Readers Notebooks
- Refer to them during guided reading and strategy groups
- Enlarge into a poster size for whole group minilessons

There are 2 sizes of the chart available. The smaller size is perfect for students to use during independent reading.

Color and blackline versions are available for each chart. Students can color in the B&W charts.

There is also a version of the chart that lists synonyms for the emotion words. Students can add additional emotions to the bottom row. They can draw in the faces and the synonyms they find.
