



## Preparation & Directions

Preparation: Print all pages and cut along the black lines – each page contains two pages of the book. Laminate and bind together by either hole punching with key rings or with a binding machine.

Auditory Discrimination Directions: Give your student a small ball of play dough, a dry erase marker, or have your student use his finger. Instruct your student to pop the balloon with the picture he hears you say. Example: “Pop ‘Peach’” and your student smashes the ball of play dough, dabs with a dry erase marker, or touches with his finger the balloon with the peach picture and not the beach picture.

Speech Production Directions: Give your student a ball of play dough, a dry erase marker, or have your student use his finger. Instruct your student to name the pictures on both of the balloons before popping them.
